WHY GOSPEL PROJECT FOR KIDS CURRICULUM?

The Gospel Project® for Kids is a unique curriculum that immerses kids in the gospel through every story, theological concept, and call to mission from Genesis to Revelation. Ultimately, the gospel message changes everything; heart transformation can only take place when a child experiences the gospel. Through The Gospel Project, kids will understand the Bible is not just a collection of stories, but one unified story—God's story of redemption.

All our children ages 4 + up, are learning the same story every week to make reviewing the lessons easy for parents. At each age level children are chronologically taught the Gospel, through age-appropriate videos, illustrations, activity pages, object lessons, a weekly Big Picture Question & Answer and Key Passage memorization.

Lastly, the Gospel Project Curriculum has an App available, which includes family devotionals, videos, activities, music and more. This provides parents with five days of simple devotionals for each lesson in the curriculum. That way, parents can follow up Monday-Friday with what we teach in church on Sunday! See link below...

RESOURCES FOR HOME DISCIPLESHIP:

One of the reasons Grace Church likes this curriculum so much is because it also gives options for families to reinforce and build upon what children are learning in their Sunday school class. It allows us to truly partner with parents in the discipling of our church's children. Here are some resources we encourage all our parents to use at home:

Big Picture Cards for Families – Families can use the Big Picture Cards that are sent home each week to review the Bible story. Show the picture to your child and let him or her explain details of the story. Ask the Big Picture Question, and allow your child to supply the answer and then discuss it together. Talk about the Christ Connection and help your child find the key passage in the Bible and read it aloud.

Gospel Project for Kids App – This is a quarterly App that coincides with what kids are learning on Sunday mornings. It provides five days of simple devotionals, videos, activities, and more, to reinforce each lesson.



SUNDAY MORNING CHECK-IN/OUT PROCEDURES:

1. To “check-in” your child, fill out a name tag at the check-in table. Please note any special instructions for your child or allergies your child may have. Keep the stub on the name tag to show when you pick up your child.
2. Sign your child in. Write his/her name and name tag number on the attendance sheet.
3. If you plan on attending church on a regular basis, please fill out a registration form for your child.
4. If we feel your child needs your assistance during the service, we will notify you with a tap on the shoulder. :)
5. To pick up your child, show the classroom teacher the stub from your child's name tag.

Please use discretion if your child has had a fever in the last 24 hours or is visibly sick.
